SafeMa Hubs for excellence in midwifery are established in the participating Asian universities to develop, share, and transfer knowledge around midwifery along with their contribution to overcome challenges faced by midwifes. Under the technical support of European partners, a network of SafeMa project is established to improve Asian partner HEIs' capacities and, consequently, to generate and spread excellence in midwifery education and research in Vietnam and Cambodia.

In the context of the SafeMa project, a hub has been developed in each Partner University. The hubs offer facilities for knowledge sharing and transfer, research and skills development, intra-and extra- university partnership building, career guidance, awareness-raising planning and events and expert workshops. The hubs are used by academic staff, researchers, and students
