## Midwifery as a Primary Health Gatekeeper: Investing on Education

### State of the art

Improving maternal and newborn health was one of the Millennium Development Goals' unfinished agendas, and it has remained a high priority of the Sustainable Development Goals era.

It is well documented internationally that midwives are the solution to achieving a substantial reduction in maternal and neonatal mortality and stillbirths. However, to realise this potential, midwives need to have the recommended skills and competencies, be part of a team of sufficient size and skill, and work in an enabling environment

### Scope of the conference

Discuss health trends and challenges in maternal and newborn health in the SEA Region with an emphasis a) on the role of midwifery and b) the necessary educational processes that need to be introduced c) the role of the EU in the framework of its external strategy. Showcase SafeMa educational model as a best practice project and discuss with all relevant stakeholders the implementation and sustainability challenges and opportunities.
